We have been pursuing a reduction in the speed limit outside of school to make the road safer for our children as they are coming to and from school. Please could you be mindful of this and park in alternative places so that we can continue to pursue the slower speed limit. With children having to walk on narrow paths, we want to minimise the risk of accidents as much as possible.
