Building work

Just a reminder that our building work is due to start this week. The contractors (Simpsons) will be cordoning off the area that they will be working in. Access to school will still be via the front gate and there will be a further gate at the top of the steps leading to the playground. This gate will be locked at playtimes and PE as it is now, but left unlocked during the rest of the day so that there is access to the school. In the mornings, our Reception Class will need to come onto the main playground and line up in their usual position from playtimes. Mrs. Robson will come out via Miss. Straw's class to collect the children, and will come out this way at the end of the day too. Parents are able to come onto the playground and meet their children at the end of the day. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to come in and see me.

School Disco

Just a reminder that tickets for the school disco on Thursday 4th April can be bought from the school office for £3.50. This price includes a drink and there will be sweets available to buy from a tuck shop. There are a few tickets remaining if anyone would like one from the office. Children can be picked up from the Hawsker School playground at 6.30pm. Staff will bring children over to the playground for collection at this time.

PE Kits and school uniform

Please can you ensure that your child's PE bag is in school every day. Sometimes PE changes due to timetable constraints or other things going on, so having PE bags in school at all times will ensure children can take part. We also encourage children to have a water bottle in school so that they can help themselves to a drink during the day. At the same time, can we also remind you that PE kits and uniforms need to be named. With the warmer weather, it has been hard to identify jumpers!
